

Reduced Rate

- Reduced Rate Info
- DPR offers a reduced rate for summer camps to DC residents who qualify. Visit <u>dprsummercamp.com</u> to find the online application.
- After completing the form, applicants will be contacted by DPR to upload to your account or schedule an appointment to provide the required proof of residency and income.
- Qualifying families will receive either a 50% or 75% discount, depending on income level.
- The application is only for a reduced rate and does NOT secure a spot in camp.
- To receive a reduced rate, residents MUST apply by April 1, 2023 in order to be approved by the time the lottery is run.

APRIL 5 - Summer Camp Lottery Closes

APRIL 18 - Notification via Email of Lottery Selection

APRIL 25- Payment Due

Guidelines:

3 locations selections can be made per child per session (For Little Explorers and Discovery Camp).

- •Participant age is calculated by session start date.
- •Sibling preferences will be honored.
- •Lottery registration is for DC residents only. Non-resident registration will be on a first come, first serve basis starting May 1.
